

ORDINANCE NO. O2020-21

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND REJECTING BIDS FOR
THE PURCHASE OF A SLUDGE TRUCK**

Pursuant to Resolution No. R2019-09, passed by the City Commission on November 19, 2019, the City Manager advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, for the purchase of a sludge truck for the wastewater plant.

The bids submitted were filed with the City Manager until 12:00 Noon, Tuesday, June 23, 2020, at which time they were duly opened and read. All of said bids are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, the bid of Worldwide Equipment is the lowest and most responsible bid for the purchase of a sludge truck.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio, that the bid of Worldwide Equipment, 408 New Goff Mt. Road, Cross Lanes, WV 25313, is hereby declared the lowest and most responsible bid for the purchase of a sludge truck for the wastewater plant, and the said as incorporated hereinabove is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2: The City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to Worldwide Equipment.

SECTION 3: All other bids and parts of bids are hereby rejected.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage as an emergency measure.
