

ORDINANCE NO. O2021-22

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 712
"MOBILE FOOD VENDING"
OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE
CITY OF GALLIPOLIS, OHIO**

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis is desirous of promoting the health and welfare of the Citizenry by establishing and enforcing certain rules relating to mobile food vending; and

WHEREAS, an integral part of the enforcement of said code provisions is the establishment and enforcement of penalties, fines, executions, and legal remedies for violations; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing amendments to this ordinance to better establish clear rules for mobile food vending.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Section 712 which reads as follows:

Chapter 712 - Mobile Food Vending

Sections:

712.01 - Definitions.

When used in this chapter:

- (a) "Board" shall mean the Office of Code Enforcement.
- (b) "Commercial zone" shall mean a geographic area that has a combination of public right of way access, vehicular traffic patterns, pedestrian density, and mobility options, such that reasonable access for mobile food vending does not constitute an unreasonable threat to public health and safety.
- (c) "Congestion zone" shall mean a geographic area that has a combination of public right of way parking limitations, meter restrictions, vehicular traffic patterns,

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest possible time allowed by law.
