**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING
THE CITY AUDITOR TO REQUEST BIDS FOR A LOAN FOR
PURCHASE OF PROPERTY AT 512 SECOND AVENUE
FOR CONSTRUCTION OF GALLIPOLIS JUSTICE CENTER COMPLEX**

WHEREAS, the Gallipolis City Commission desires to build the Gallipolis Justice Center Complex to house the Gallipolis Municipal Court and Municipal Law Enforcement Offices; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to purchase property at 512 Second Avenue for said construction and to request bids for a loan for such property purchase; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Resolution as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio;



SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.


