

RESOLUTION NO. R2012-14

**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING
THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR
THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW MUNICIPAL BUILDING
TO HOUSE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES**

WHEREAS, the Gallipolis City Commission desires to build a new Municipal Building to house Administrative Offices; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to request bids for such project; and

WHEREAS, the project was previously bid this year and bids were opened on Friday, April 27, 2012 for the project; and all bids exceeded the engineer's estimate; and

WHEREAS, the specifications for the municipal building have been revised; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Resolution as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio;



SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.


