

ORDINANCE NO. O2016-15

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O2014-49, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES SECTION OF THE STATE AUDITOR'S OFFICE (GASB-34 LOOK-ALIKE STATEMENTS) FOR FISCAL YEARS 2014 AND 2015

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Ordinance No. O2014-49 to provide for additional services in the compilation of the GASB-34 look-alike statements for 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio,

Section 1: That SECTION 2 which reads as follows:

SECTION 2: The City Auditor is authorized at the direction of the City Manager to draw her warrants payable to the State Auditor's Office for an amount not to exceed Seven Thousand Two Hundred Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$7,250.00) for FY 2014 and Four Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$4,500.00) for FY 2015.


IS HEREBY AMENDED to read as follows:


SECTION 2: The City Auditor is authorized at the direction of the City Manager to draw her warrants payable to the State Auditor's Office for an amount not to exceed Seven Thousand Two Hundred Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$7,250.00) for FY 2014 and Six Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$6,000.00) for FY 2015.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage as an emergency measure.




