

ORDINANCE NO. O2016-50

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER
TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH THE
LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES SECTION
OF THE STATE AUDITOR'S OFFICE
(GASB-34 LOOK-ALIKE STATEMENTS)
FOR FISCAL YEARS 2016 AND 2017**

WHEREAS, it is required by state law that the City of Gallipolis be audited; and
WHEREAS, the State Auditor's Office will provide services for the conversion of the financial statements for the fiscal years 2016 and 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis has decided to allow the State Auditor's Office to do the GASB-34 Look-alike Statements for the fiscal years 2016 and 2017.

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio,


SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into agreement with the Local Government Services Section of the State Auditor's Office for 2016 and 2017 GASB-34 conversion.

SECTION 2: The City Auditor is authorized at the direction of the City Manager to draw her warrants payable to the State Auditor's Office for an amount not to exceed Seven Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$7,000.00) for FY 2016 and Seven Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$7,000.00) for FY 2017.


SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.




