

**ORDINANCE NO. O2022-13**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER NO. 921.05,  
WATER RATES, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES  
OF THE CITY OF GALLIPOLIS, OHIO**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gallipolis, Ohio wishes to freeze the increase in the rates for water usage in 2022 and resume the three percent (3%) increase in 2023, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission voted to freeze the increase in the rates for water usage in the years 2019, 2020 and 2021 and wishes to amend Chapter No. 921.05 to codify said votes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio:

**SECTION I:** That Section 921.05 Rates, which reads as follows:

**921.05 RATES**

- (a) The City Manager is authorized and directed to adopt and put into effect for the users of water from the City water system the rates and charges in this section.
- (b) The metered rates for users of water inside the corporation limits shall be billed per hundred gallons and read to the nearest hundred gallons. The metered rates inside the corporation limits shall be as follows:

<u>Gallons / Month</u>	<u>Rates</u>
First 1,000	\$12.03
1,100 – 3,000	0.266
3,100 – 100,000	0.248
100,100 – 500,000	0.214
500,100 – 1,000,000	0.204
Over 1,000,000	0.192

Minimum:

Residential (1,000 gallons)	\$12.03
Commerical (3,000 gallons)	17.36

- (c) The meter rates for users of water outside the corporation limits shall be billed per hundred gallons and read to the nearest hundred gallons. The metered rates outside the corporation limits shall be as follows:

First 1,000	\$22.17
1,100 – 3,000	0.488
3,100 – 100,000	0.445
100,100 – 500,000	0.310
500,100 – 1,000,000	0.281
Over 1,000,000	0.257

Minimum:

Residential (1,000 gallons)	\$22.17
Commerical (3,000 gallons)	31.92

- (d) All amounts shall be payable monthly. If any water bill remains unpaid past the due date, an additional ten percent (10%) shall be added to the unpaid bill. If the utility bill remains unpaid and the water service is shut off as a result thereof, a twenty-dollar (\$20.00) fee shall be charged to reinstate and continue service.
- (e) Right of Appeal. All customers shall have the right to appeal bills rendered for water service charges. In the event that a billing dispute cannot be resolved by the utility billing department that initially rendered the bill, it shall become the responsibility of the City Manager or his designee to resolve such dispute.
- (f) The new rates shall be effective the November 2004 utility billing. The water rates shall increase three percent (3%) each year as reflected in the first bill sent in April of each successive year.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period of time allowed by law.

BE, AND IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

**921.05 RATES**

- (g) The City Manager is authorized and directed to adopt and put into effect for the users of water from the City water system the rates and charges in this section.
- (h) The metered rates for users of water inside the corporation limits shall be billed per hundred gallons and read to the nearest hundred gallons. The metered rates inside the corporation limits shall be as follows:

- (i) The meter rates for users of water outside the corporation limits shall be billed per hundred gallons and read to the nearest hundred gallons. The metered rates outside the corporation limits shall be as follows:

- (j) All amounts shall be payable monthly. If any water bill remains unpaid past the due date, an additional ten percent (10%) shall be added to the unpaid bill. If the utility bill remains unpaid and the water service is shut off as a result thereof, a twenty-dollar (\$20.00) fee shall be charged to reinstate and continue service.
- (k) Right of Appeal. All customers shall have the right to appeal bills rendered for water service charges. In the event that a billing dispute cannot be resolved by the utility billing department that initially rendered the bill, it shall become the responsibility of the City Manager or his designee to resolve such dispute.
- (l) The new rates shall be effective the November 2004 utility billing. The water rates shall increase three percent (3%) each year as reflected in the first bill sent in April of each successive year. The rates shall not increase in the years 2019, 2020,

2021 and 2022. The 3% increase shall resume in 2023 in the first bill sent in April and each successive year.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period of time allowed by law.
