

**ORDINANCE NO. O2022-16**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT FOR VISION INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES AND ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF GALLIPOLIS, OHIO**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gallipolis is desirous of providing Vision Insurance coverage for full-time employees and elected and appointed officials of the City; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1:** The City Manager is authorized to enter into agreement for vision insurance coverage for full-time employees and elected and appointed officials of the City of Gallipolis for a vision insurance plan with the Wiseman Agency, for the VSP Signature plan, VSP, 3333 Quality Drive, Rancho Cordova, California 95670 for an amount not to exceed \$13.98 per full-time employee or appointed or elected official per month.

**SECTION 2:** That the City Auditor is authorized at the direction of the City Manager to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to Vision Signature Plan, P. O. Box 742109, Los Angeles, California 90074-2109, for vision insurance coverage for the amount of \$13.98 per full-time employee or appointed or elected official per month. Employees may elect for the family insurance coverage at an additional \$8.14 biweekly.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period of time allowed by law for the insurance policy coverage period from September 1, 2022 through August 31, 2024.
