

There was presented and read to the Commission for a first reading Ordinance No. O2023-20 entitled **AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 91-1, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 94-23, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 97-119, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 98-116, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. O2021-20, AND ESTABLISHING PAID HOLIDAYS FOR APPOINTED OFFICIALS AND FULL-TIME MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES.** Mr. Brown made a motion to place the ordinance on the first reading, seconded by Dr. Thomas. Upon voice vote to place the ordinance on the first reading, all votes were yes.

The City Manager confirmed with the commission that the passage of this ordinance on first reading and the ordinance language being retroactive would give him the authority to notify employees that Juneteenth on Monday, June 19, 2023, will be a paid holiday off.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
