

**ORDINANCE NO. O2023-24**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND REJECTING BIDS FOR  
SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL**

Pursuant to Resolution No. R2022-14, passed by the City Commission on October 17, 2022, the City Manager advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, according to law and the Charter of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio for solid waste collection and disposal.

The bids submitted were filed with the City Manager until 12:00 noon, on Friday, July 28, 2023, at which time they were duly opened and read. All of said bids are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio, that the bid of Rumpke of Ohio, Inc. is hereby declared the lowest and most responsible bid for solid waste collection and disposal, and the said as incorporated hereinabove is hereby accepted.

The City Manager is authorized to enter into contract as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That Rumpke of Ohio, Inc., 3990 Generation Drive, Cincinnati, Ohio 45251, be awarded a contract for solid waste collection and disposal as per attached bid tabulation which is hereby attached to and made a part of this ordinance as if fully written herein; total contract amount not to exceed budgetary funding.

**SECTION 2:** The City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio payable to Rumpke of Ohio, Inc. at the direction of the City Manager.

**SECTION 3:** All other bids and parts of bids are hereby rejected.

**SECTION 4:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
