

ORDINANCE NO. O2024-09

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND REJECTING BIDS FOR
ASPHALT, LIMESTONE AND BEDDING SAND**

Pursuant to Resolution No. R2024-01 passed by the City Commission on January 02, 2024, the City Manager advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, for asphalt, limestone and bedding sand.

The bids submitted were filed with the City Manager until 12:00 Noon, Tuesday, March 19, 2024, at which time they were duly opened and read. All of said bids are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, the bid of the three companies that submitted competitive bids are the lowest and most responsible bid for a portion of the supplies contained within the bid list.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio, that the bids of the companies listed in Section 1 are hereby declared the lowest and most responsible bids for asphalt, limestone, or bedding sand, and the said as incorporated hereinabove are hereby accepted.

SECTION 1: That the following companies:

- (1) Melvin Stone Company, 228 Melvin Road, Wilmington, OH;
- (2) Letart Corporation, P.O. Box 69, Gallipolis Ferry, WV;
- (3) Shelly Materials Inc., P. O. Box 266, Thornville, OH;

be awarded a contract for line items as per attached bid tabulation. The total contract amount is not to exceed budgetary funding.

SECTION 2: The City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to Melvin Stone Company, Letart Corporation, and Shelly Materials.

SECTION 3: All other bids and parts of bids are hereby rejected.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage as an emergency measure.
